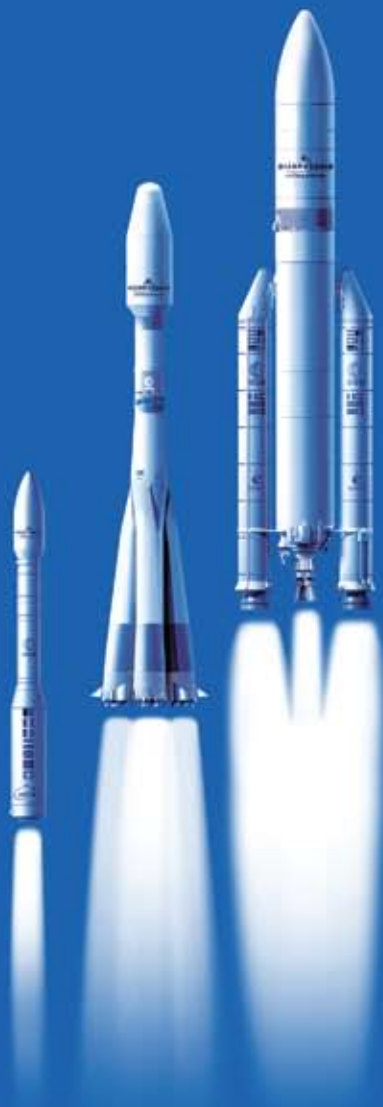

Arianespace's Soyuz will launch the first four satellites for Europe's Galileo space-based navigation system. These payloads will be orbited in pairs during the second half of 2010 by two Soyuz vehicles operating from the Spaceport in French Guiana.
